Jeppesen Obstacle Database for cycle 2013, effective 03 December 2020 and cycle 2014, effective 31 December 2020, contain incorrect data for Benito Juarez Intl; Mexico City, Mexico (MMMX) and Lic Adolfo Lopez Mateos Intl; Toluca, Mexico (MMTO). Mexico AIP SUP 14/20, effective 18 December 2020 was received after its effective date and after cycle 2013 and 2014 AIRAC cycle data processing due dates. Therefore, none of the Obstacles contained in Mexico AIP SUP 14/20 are included in the Obstacle Database for cycles 2013 and 2014.
