Notice of Upcoming Changes to Navigation Database Part Number 1348-14W4

Continued growth in the number of approaches and terminal waypoints in the USA will soon exceed the memory capacity of UNS-1Ms using navigation database part number 1348-14W4. As a result, we are limiting the contents of this database to stay within the UNS-1M memory limits.

Changes were originally scheduled to be effective with cycle 1010; however, unexpected additional growth in the navdata requires earlier implementation of the change.

Specifically, starting with cycle 1009, effective 26 August 2010, we are changing the contents of navigation database part number 1348-14W4 to include only one approach per runway at airports 5000' and longer. At airports with more than one approach to a particular runway, the priority will be GPS, ILS, LOC, BC, VOR DME RNAV, VOR, NDB, TAC.

Navigation database part numbers 1348-14A2, 1348-14B2 and 1348-14C2, listed below, remain unchanged.

- 1348-14A2:** 2000' Canada, Europe, Latin America, South America, USA and Pacific with two approaches per runway. Terminal coverage in USA includes only airports East of W109.
- 1348-14B2:** 2000' Africa, Eastern Europe, Europe, Pacific, Middle East and South Pacific with two approaches per runway
- 1348-14C2:** 2000' Canada, Europe, Latin America, South America, USA and Pacific with two approaches per runway. Terminal coverage in USA includes only airports West of W090.
